HEALTHY SMILES START EARLY

Children should visit the dentist by their first birthday or within six months of their first tooth appearing. Regular check-ups every six months help prevent cavities, monitor development, and promote good oral hygiene. Dentists provide cleanings, brushing and flossing tips, and help reduce dental anxiety. Sealants—thin, tooth-colored coatings usually applied to molars—protect against cavities by sealing out deep grooves. Sealants are most effective when applied soon after molars come in, around ages 6 and 12. Sealants help prevent costly treatments, keeping teeth healthy for years to come.
